### TOUR PAYMENTS: (Adjustment from the attached brochure)

The deadline for \$300 deposit is July 18, 2024, or until trip is at capacity. After that date the airlines charge a \$100 cancellation fee. Final payment is due **August 1, 2024**. We will make determination that we have enough people on or before July 18th, so we can postpone the trip and ensure you receive deposit back or move the deposit to a future trip.

**TRAVEL:**

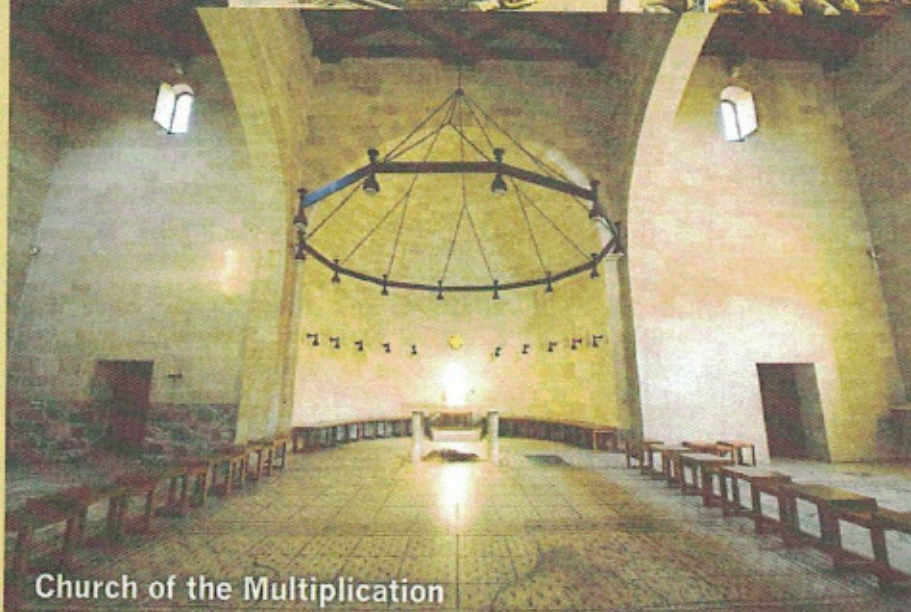

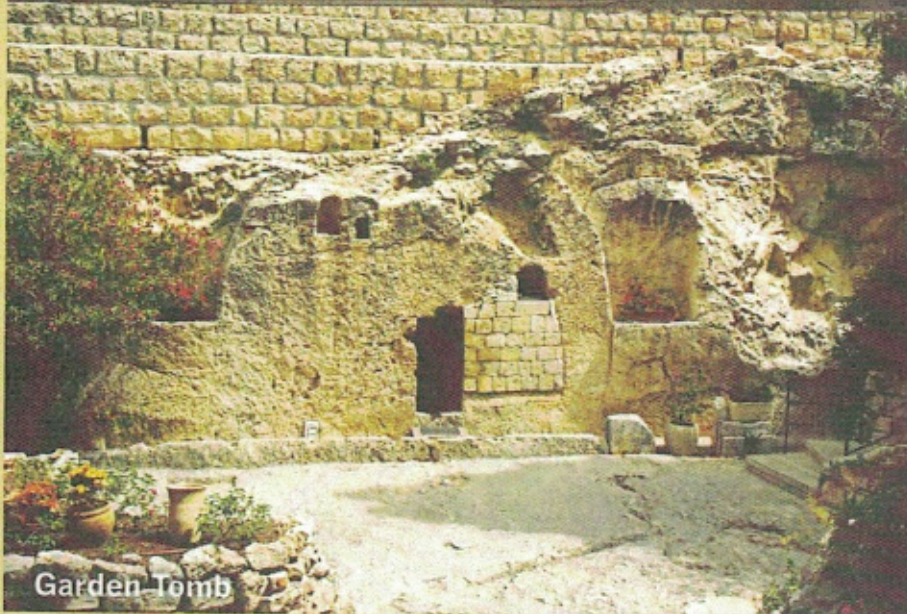

## YOUR DAILY ITINERARY

**TUE, NOV 12 OKLAHOMA CITY • CAIRO**

Depart from Oklahoma City by bus for DFW airport. Travel to Cairo Egypt. Meals and overnight on board. After dinner relax and enjoy the on-board entertainment.

**WED, NOV 13 CAIRO**

Arrive Cairo, Egypt, the land of the Pharaohs. Meet our experienced Egyptian guide who transfers us to our hotel located near the Grand Pyramid. Dinner and overnight in Cairo.

**THU, NOV 14 CAIRO • GREAT PYRAMIDS**

Morning visit to the **Egyptian Museum** which includes a collection of antiquities and the golden mask and treasures of **Tut-Ank-Amon**. In the afternoon drive to Giza to visit the **Great Pyramids**, one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world, and the **Sphinx Valley Temple**. The most adventurous will be invited to ride a camel. Dinner at the hotel. Evening optional **Sound & Light show by the Pyramids**. Dinner & overnight in Cairo.

**FRI, NOV 15 CAIRO • ST CATHERINE**

Depart today for biblical **Mt. Sinai** where Moses received the Ten Commandments. We travel through the Sinai Desert situated between the Gulf of Suez and the Gulf of Aqaba. At the southern end of the peninsula is a mass of granite mountains, some of which are 8,000 feet above sea level. The chief peak is **Jebel Musa**, "Mountain of Moses" or **Mt. Sinai**. Proceed to our pension-like hotel for dinner and overnight.

**SAT, NOV 16 CAIRO • DEAD SEA**

At about 3:00Am this morning, we begin our climb up to **Mt. Sinai** where it is believed that Moses received the Ten Commandments from God. Camels are available for rent. Return for breakfast at the hotel. We continue through the Sinai desert to the **Taba** border with Israel. Cross into Israel and travel north to the

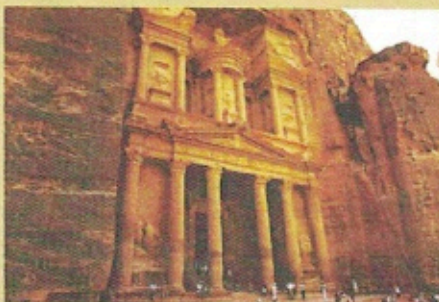
**Dead Sea**. Meet our Israeli guide who will welcome us to the **Land of the Bible** and escort us throughout our stay in Israel. Israeli guides are legendary for their knowledge and dedication. Ours will instruct us on the many sites we will visit and their relationship to the religion, history, archaeology, culture, and modern life in Israel. The **Dead Sea**, lowest point on earth. We will go for a swim, rather a "float", in the salted waters of the **Dead Sea**. Dinner and overnight at the **Dead Sea**.

**SUN, NOV 17 DEAD SEA • MASADA • EIN GEDI • TIBERIAS**

Depart to **Masada**, overlooking the **Dead Sea**, the lowest point on Earth, where we ascend by cable car to visit the remnants of **Herod's Palace** and where in 73 A.D. the Zealots made their last stand against the might of Rome. We visit **Ein Gedi**, fabled **Spring of David**.

**MON, NOV 18 SEA OF GALILEE**

Today we pass through the fast growing towns and farms of the **Plain of Sharon** enroute to **Caesarea**, site of major events in the lives of **Peter and Paul**. It's on to **Megiddo**, inspiration for James Michener's "The Source". Archaeological digs reveal 20 layers of civilization, including fortifications of **King Solomon** and the water tunnel of **King Ahab**. **Megiddo** provides a magnificent view of the fertile **Jezeel Valley**, prophesied site of **Armageddon**, at the crossroads of the ancient **Via Maris**. Driving to **Mt. Carmel**, we walk on the mountain

where Elijah triumphed over the prophets of Baal, and we visit Elijah's cave. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Tiberias.

#### TUE, NOV 19 SEA OF GALILEE

This day alone is worth the trip! We are now literally walking in the footsteps of Jesus. We will take a most memorable boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee**, in a replica of the ancient wooden boat used in Jesus' day. We will visit an ancient boat believed to be from Jesus' time found in the Sea of Galilee in 1986. We walk into old **Capernaum** with the ancient synagogue, on to the site of the **Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes (Tabgha)**, the Sermon on the Mount and the **Mount of Beatitudes**. Visit the Jesus Boat Museum. End the day with a visit to **Mt. Arbel** for a breathtaking view of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

#### WED, NOV 20 GALILEE • GOLANHEIGHTS • BANIAS

Today we will visit **Tel Dan** the beautiful waterfall on the headwaters of the Jordan River. The high place at Dan, in northern Israel, dates to 920 BC, when Israel was divided into the northern (Israel) and the southern (Judah) kingdoms. The high place measured 62 feet square and was surrounded by a wall. On top of the high place were buildings that housed the shrine or "idol" that was worshipped there. Later visit **Caesarea Phillipi (Banias Spring)** where Peter confessed, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God" (Matthew 16:16.)

View the United Nations camp and the Syrian border along the **Golan Heights**. Return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

#### THU, NOV 21 GALILEE • JERUSALEM

Drive along the **Jordan Valley** to **Gideon Springs**. Stop at **Quasar el Yahud**, the Baptism site. Visit ancient **Jericho**, one of the oldest inhabited cities. **It's now time to "go up" to Jerusalem.** We will enter the city as pilgrims did since ancient times to fulfill the words of the prophet "I was glad when they said unto me: 'Our feet shall stand within thy Gates, O Jerusalem.'" (Psalms 122:1-2) We will visit **Bethlehem** and see **Manger Square**, the **Church of the Nativity**, and view **Shepherds' Fields** and the **Fields of Boaz and Ruth**. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

#### FRI, NOV 22 JERUSALEM

Visit the scale **Model of Jerusalem** as it was during the days of our Lord. Start the day with a magnificent view of the **Old City** from the top of the **Mt. of Olives**. Take the "**Palm Sunday Walk**" to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Then drive across the **Kidron Valley**. Enter the **Old City** through **St. Stephen's Gate (Lions' Gate)** to the **Muslim Quarter**, visit the beautiful **Church of St. Anne** and the **Pool of Bethesda**, **Pilate's Judgment Hall**, and the **Ecce Homo Arch**. Walk along the **Via Dolorosa**, into the **Christian Quarter**, and see the **Stations of the Cross**. Visit

the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. Drive to **Mt. Zion** to see the **House of Caiaphas**. Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem**.

#### SAT, NOV 23 JERUSALEM

Start the day with a visit to the important excavations taking place at the **Western Wall** and the **Southern Temple Staircase**. Proceed down into the **Western Wall Tunnels** and see the recent excavations taking place below the wall. On to the **Temple Mount**, where Abraham was to sacrifice Isaac. See the **Dome of the Rock** and **al-Aqsa Mosque** that now stands there. Proceed to the **City of David**. Visit the City and travel through **Hezekiah's Tunnel**. We visit the **Garden Tomb**, believed by some to be the site of Jesus' crucifixion, burial and resurrection. This evening we attend a **Farewell Dinner** at the hotel and exchange stories of this life changing experience. Overnight Jerusalem.

#### SUN, NOV 24 TEL AVIV • OKLAHOMA CITY

This morning we transfer to the airport for our flight home. Our guide will assist with check in procedures. Depart **Tel Aviv** for **Dallas Fort Worth**. Arrival **Dallas** the same day with wonderful memories of the Holy Land. Bus to **Oklahoma City**.

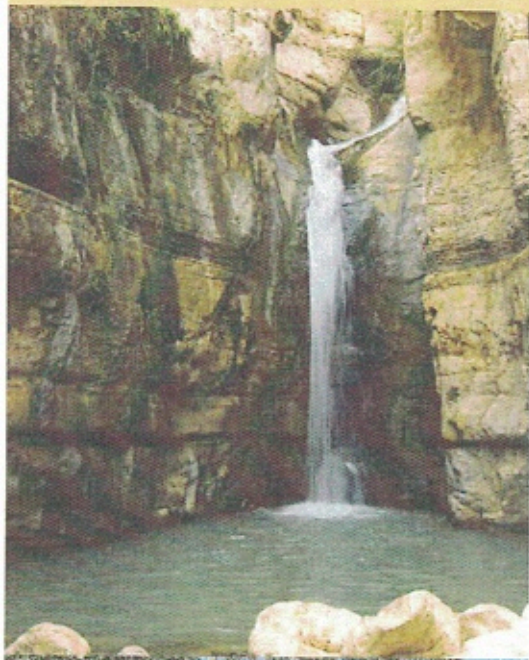

On behalf of all our staff here in the States as well as in Israel, we wish to thank you for booking with Friendship Tours. The leader in Christian Pilgrimages. We wish you a safe and happy journey as you travel through the land of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

1. Friendship Tours will provide economy class air transportation. **Once you are at the airport and you experience any delays or flight cancellations, you are required to contact the airline ticket counter or customer service desk at the airport. At that point Friendship Tours cannot help you! You are in the hands of the airline.**

2. Since you are traveling as a group, seat assignments have been made by the airline. You will be seated together as a group. Couples and roommates are seated together. Please contact the airport check-in staff for any changes you wish to make. **Friendship Tours cannot assist you with seat assignments.**

Land Only Passengers – If you arrive & depart at the same time as the group, you are welcome to board our bus for airport transfers. Otherwise, you are responsible to make your own transfer arrangements or take taxis to the hotel. Please give your group leader a copy of your flight details.

3. Your luggage will be checked all the way to **CAIRO** from the city of origin. Same thing on the return, your luggage will be checked through from **CARIO** to your destination. Do not lock your suitcase before checking in luggage. Airport security will do random luggage checks and break the lock or not allow your luggage to go onboard the plane. Please keep all luggage unlocked at all times. (TSA locks are okay) Each person is allowed to check in one standard size suitcase weighing no more than 50 pounds. One carry on bag not to exceed 15 pounds.

4. You cannot use air miles to upgrade to business class on the type of fare we have used. You will need to book your travel with the airline directly if you wish to use air miles. Airlines do not work with us on air miles.

5. **Your passport is required to have 6 months left before expiration from the date of your return.** No immunizations are required. But please check with your physician.

6. Put a photocopy of your passport in the bottom of your suitcase in case you lose it or it gets stolen. This will make the process of getting a new one issued much quicker.

7. We suggest you carry some over the counter medicine for minor ailments. Please ensure you carry all your prescription medication in your carry-on luggage and not in your checked luggage. Just in case your luggage gets misplaced, you will still have your daily medication on you. Make sure you have the generic name of the medication. **Please do not ever carry anything for anyone known or unknown.** This could endanger your life and cause you serious problems.

8. It is suggested that you call your Credit Card Company and inform them that you are planning to travel out of the country and will be using it. Many times, they will reject your card at purchase thinking it has been stolen. This is strongly advised. Write down the numbers of the credit cards you will be taking with you and the emergency number to call in case lost or stolen. Put this in your suitcase or a different place from where you are keeping your cards.

9. Buffet breakfasts and dinners are included on your tour. Soft drinks and bottled water with meals are not included in your tour cost. You will be billed for this. **Coffee is not included with dinners.** You will be billed for it. Coffee is included with all breakfasts.

10. You can bring snacks as long as they are in sealed bags from the store. No fresh fruit or vegetables.

11. Buses in Israel will be selling bottled water on board. Please do not consume foods on the bus. Snacks are fine.
12. The temp in Israel will be in the mid 80's during the day to low 60's at night.
13. Clothing on the tour is casual. Jeans and shirts are fine for men and women. **Your guides will advise you of any required attire when entering certain religious sites.** We suggest you carry two pairs of good walking shoes that you have been wearing for a while. Don't try and break in a new pair on the tour.
14. You will be responsible for all lunches, which will average between \$15 to \$18 depending on what you buy.
15. All hotels have a business center that is equipped with computers and internet access. Charges vary from hotel to hotel. There also are Internet cafes in Jerusalem.
16. The official currency in Israel is the Shekel. They will accept U.S. Dollars but the change will be given back in local Shekels.
17. Notify a neighbor you will be gone and give them a contact number in case of an emergency with your home. (You may want to show them where water and gas shutoff valves are located.)
18. For your safety and security, Israel airport security is very tight. Please offer your utmost cooperation to the security staff. They are very kind and are doing a great job of making sure you are safe. Do not joke with them. Answer all questions to the point and remember, when they search your luggage, it's not about you and it certainly is not personal. They do this with most passengers traveling to the States.
19. Friendship Tours highly recommends Trip Insurance. **Go over the coverage's offered** and contact the insurance carrier with any questions you may have. Mail your completed application and check directly to the insurance company. **Trip insurance may be purchased till the day before departure.**
20. Taxi cabs – When traveling on your own and separate from the tour group, we recommend you travel in groups of 4 or more. Use only metered taxis. Avoid public buses. Avoid interacting with the locals who you do not know. Stay within your group. Look out for one another. If possible, avoid staying out too late at nights and try to avoid large crowds and gatherings.
21. Food & Drinks – Avoid consuming any street food. This may not have been hygienically prepared. Drink only bottled water. Each of our systems react differently to international foods and water. Why take a chance of getting sick and ruining your vacation.
22. Pick pockets in the Old City – Yes, unfortunately this is common and very rampant in the places you will be visiting. Protect your passport. Today, a U.S passport is one of the most sought-after items. Don't be a victim! There are safes in your hotel rooms and on board the ship in your cabin. Please lock your passport safely as soon as you enter.
